
Greetings. It is really a great pleasure to write this letter of recommendation for my friend, Carol House. I was one of literally thousands of people who benefited from her work as Coordinator of the Grand Rapids "March for Jesus" just one year ago, and there are few public events I have participated in that I would count as successful. I myself, at the time, was coordinating a large evangelistic campaign here in Grand Rapids, so I know what Mrs. House had to have done well to have accomplished what she did.

Clearly, Carol is a skilled and gifted administrator. She has the ability to assess people's talents, strengths and weaknesses; then channel them into responsibilities they can handle effectively. More importantly, she has the faith to release people into work in a way that affirms and emboldens them. She is a highly responsible person, and is able to make a firm commitment to a difficult task and then see it through to completion. She deals with obstacles as opportunities, and her positive attitude in the face of difficulty is infectious -- it inspires others to similar courage and perseverance.
